Categories:

1. KATA- a sequence of movements that students are learning in class;(Taikyoku 1,Heian 1,2,3,4,5 etc)
2. KUMITE - partner work; includes combos that they have practiced in class; 5, 3, 1 step,or semifree.
Adult brown and black belts -Jiyu kumite [Shobu Ippon 2 minute match].
3. TEAM KATA - a 3-student team performing synchronized kata.

Fees & Deadline: \$25 for 1, 2 or 3 events Nov 19, 2011

A \$10 LATE FEE.will be charged this year. Please avoid this fee and register early.

Competitors: The competitors will be divided into three or more age groups (8 -12, 12–17,18 & up for individual kata and kumite: There will be rank divisions (beginners, intermediates, & advanced white belts (Saturday) yellow belts, orange belts, green , blue , brown and black).

Competitors should bring a snack, sweatshirts, socks and a water bottle. Safety plexi-glasses. No jewelry. Flat white hand protectors for brown + black. Wild running around in the gym is unexceptable.
